Online Baptism Class preparation for Parents and Sponsors

1. Register to FORMED- go to www.saintrosechurch.formed.org
2. Create a New Account: Please make sure you choose our parish: St. Rose of Lima with this address: [642 Trigo Lane Paso Robles CA.](#) click "next" It will then ask you for your full name and email address. SIGN UP
3. Now on FORMED go to sacraments scroll down to **REBORN**.
4. You will see 3 sessions, parents must complete all three sessions:
Session 1- A new Creation
Session 2- Entering the Mystery
Session 3- Nurturing the Life of Grace

Very Important: In order to get credit for the class you must answer the questions attached and email them back to strose@saintrosechurch.org

Questions to be answered by parents:

Why do you desire Baptism for your child? What is your deepest desire for your child in Baptism?

What are some choices you have already made for your child? What would be the potential consequences of delaying these decisions until the child is old enough to make those decisions for him/herself? Why do you think it is important for you to choose Baptism for your child? What are some of the reasons you are choosing Baptism for your child?

The Catechism states, "Incorporated into Christ by Baptism, the person baptized is configured to Christ. Baptism seals the Christian with the indelible spiritual mark (character) of his belonging to Christ" (CCC 1272). This indelible seal marks us as belonging to God, and nothing can change or erase the seal of Baptism. What does it mean to you to be marked as belonging to Christ? Why is it important to you that your child be marked by this seal now?

How do you see the godparents you chose for your child impacting the faith of your child?

Questions to be answered by godparents:

What does it mean to be a godparent?

How will you assist the parents on the road to Christian life for your godchild?

Heavenly Father, in Baptism you have made us your own and marked us with an indelible seal. May we have the strength and courage to truly live our lives conformed to Christ, and to guide those entrusted to us in the faith of the Church.
